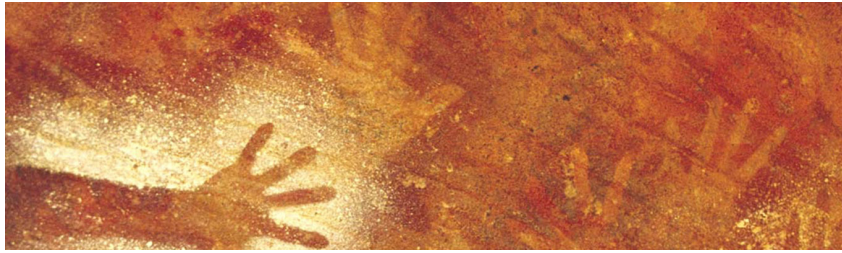


Spirituality and Social Transformation
