



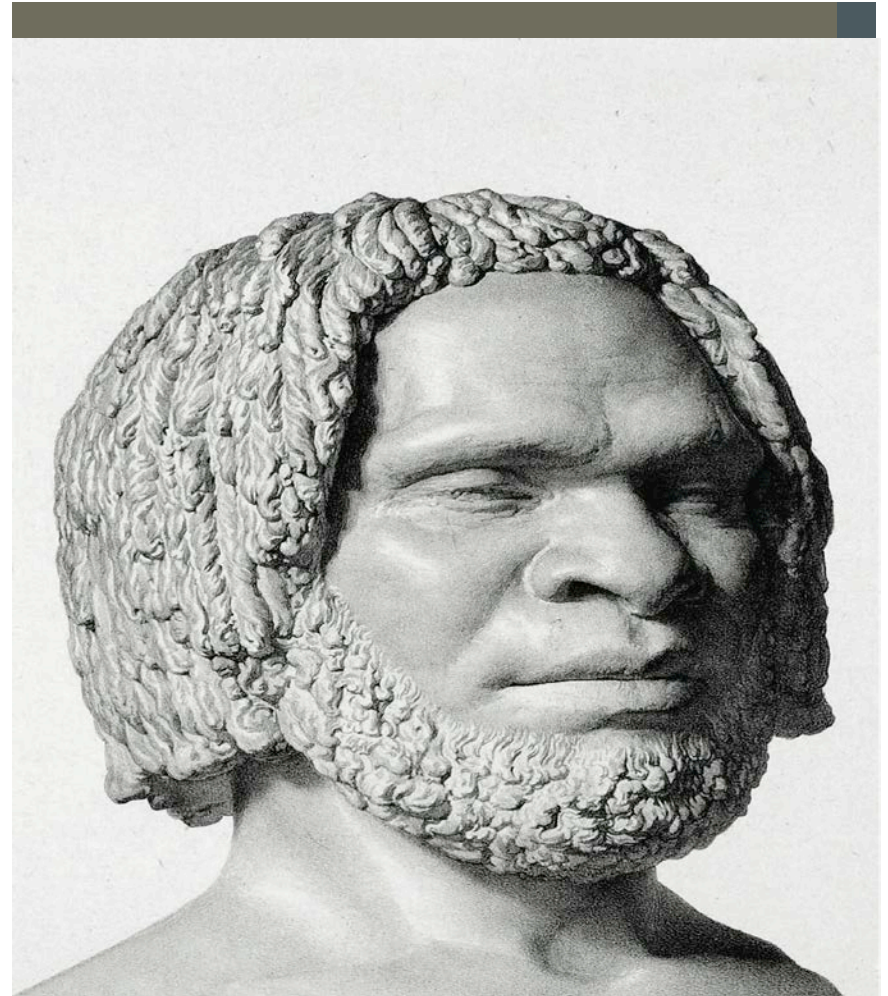
Sunday December 4

Men's Circle. Men and boys making music sticks, throwing weapons, model canoes, fire-brands, string: Working with wood, fibre and paper-bark.

Children's Circle: Learning dance, Painting with ochre and story telling with Elders. Contests and games for everyone.

Lunch: Cooking and serving cultural foods and sizzling sausages. Tastings of seafood, mutton birds, kangaroo patties, damper.

Celebrating with Dance and Song: Led by Song Man, Uncle Ronnie Summers, with dance performances.

A Special Ceremony will be held at Little Musselroe Inlet to conclude the day's formal program. All welcome!

12 noon Her Excellency The Honourable Kate Warner AM, Governor of Tasmania will join us for a very special Flag Raising and Welcome Ceremony. The unveiling of Mannalargenna's Memorial Plaque and the Governor's Address as Patron of Mannalargenna Day will follow this, along with a Presentation Ceremony.
